


Cotton-top Tamarin (*Saguinus oedipus*) Faecal Scoring Chart

Type 1: Separate hard pellets, round or oval in shape. Primarily dry. No residue left after removal.

Type 2: Firm but not hard. Pellets form one fecal unit that is moist with distinct segmentation.

Type 3: Soft and log-like in shape, moist dough-like consistency, segmentation is not present.

Type 4: Portions may be formed but inconsistent. A mushy stool that may occur in blobs.

Type 5: Has texture but cannot hold a vertical shape. Some splattering may occur.

Type 6: Watery and presents as a flat puddle. Heavy splattering is likely to occur.
